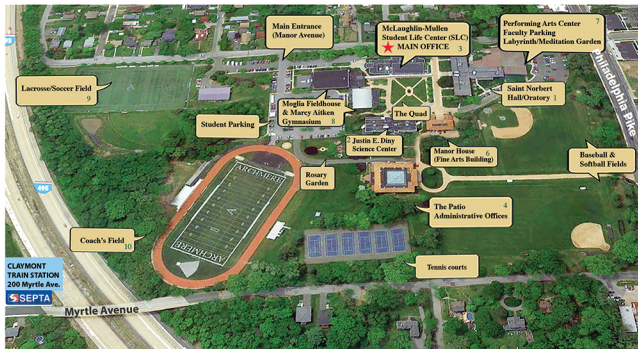


Located in Claymont DE, just north of Wilmington, DE and 30 minutes south of Philadelphia, PA, Archmere is a private, Catholic, college preparatory co-educational academy, grades 9-12, founded in 1932 by the Norbertine Fathers.

Archmere Academy's campus is composed of timeless historical structures, state-of-the-art buildings and all-weather turf athletic fields situated on 38 beautiful and sprawling acres. Archmere Academy sits close to the borders of its neighboring states and is easily accessible to families living in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Maryland.

SAINT NORBERT HALL
Built in 1957, St. Norbert Hall has recently undergone a massive interior renovation. The building functions as the "academic hub" of our campus, housing 30 classrooms, a Technology Center, 10 study rooms, 3 common areas, 5 academic departments, the Library, the Oratory, and administrative offices.



JUSTIN E. DINY SCIENCE CENTER
Named for former Archmere Headmaster and teacher Justin E. Diny O. Praem. In 1973, our science center includes classrooms and laboratories, a greenhouse, aquariums, and a lecture hall.



MCLAUGHLIN-MULLEN STUDENT LIFE CENTER (The "SLC")
The Student Life Center is home to Archmere's Main Office, School Nurse, College Counseling, Guidance Department, the Auk Café, school stores, and serves as the main dining area for the campus. The SLC was named for former headmasters Father MCLAughlin, O.Praem (Headmaster 1983-1996, 2006-2010) and Father Mullen, O.Praem.'63. (Headmaster 1997-2004).



THE PATIO
Original home of the Raskob family, The Patio Estate was purchased by Bernard Pennings, Abbott of the Norbertine Order in 1932. The building was placed on the United States Register of Historic Places in 2007.

The Patio is the home of Archmere's administrative offices including the Headmaster, Admissions, the Business Office and the Office of Institutional Advancement. The Patio also includes classrooms and a refurbished bowling alley, which today functions as a dance and yoga studio for students. "Archmere" (Arch to the Sea) was a custom-built country estate on the banks of the Delaware River for John J. and Helena Springer Green Raskob and their 13 children. Personally designed for the family by Alexander Harper and James McClure of the firm of McKim, Meade, and White, the Patio is an exceptional example of the Neo-classical art and architecture of the Italian Renaissance, created during the early part of the 20th century.
